CONSTRUCTION UPDATE

Building number 2 – The Birch Tower – will be completed and ready for occupancy on May 17, 2021. The landscaping related to phase II will be completed by the end of May 2021.

An additional patio has been added to the Woodlands. It is on the west side of the Commons and can be accessed through the outside door of the Multi-purpose room. It will be completed by the end of May 2021.

The pad for the foundation of Building number 3 – The Willow Tower – has been completed and this will allow for an early start to The Willow Tower in 2022.



Heating and Cooling System

Many types of heating systems were evaluated for the Woodlands. The PTHP (packaged terminal heat pump) was determined to be the best system for these condominium units. The PTHPs are controlled by a thermostat in each room and there is a setting for heating and one for cooling. The heat pump pulls the outside air and converts it to warm or cool air. Optimally, they are designed to be set at the desired temperature and they will operate efficiently. The advantages to the PTHPs are that they give each owner more control over the heating and cooling of their living space, and – especially important in these COVID times – the air in each unit comes directly from the outside and is not shared with others in the Woodlands.
